Front wheel assist permitted,
Dual rear wheels permitted
No hand cut drive tires

Disqualifications:

Any acceleration or up shifting after half track will result in disqualification

Use of Cell Phones or other communication equipment of any kind once the tractor has entered the track area

Failure to follow and comply with track official request

Failure to stopping when track official displays the red flag

A blatant disregard of a track official will result in the driver and tractor being disqualified for the remainder of the night

No arguing with a track official

No crew members are permitted on the track at any time

No Alcohol is permitted on the fairgrounds
